The LawLine is available from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Mondays, Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

Services are free, but clients may be required to pay other costs, such as court costs, witness fees and medical record copies. VLAS attorneys can work with clients to determine how to meet such costs.

The society can help with a variety of civil legal issues, such as Social Security and unemployment benefits, mortgage foreclosures, child custody and visitation, collections and repossessions, and others.

Because of confidentiality issues, although Christ Episcopal Church is the host site for VLAS, they do not make appointments for and cannot assist prospective clients in any way.
